

OUTDOOR-CARPET

INFORMATION ON THE MATERIAL

MATERIAL

The carpet face consists of textiles and the backing is made of PVC with air holes.

PROPERTIES

This textile product is 100 % suitable for daily outdoor use and is proven to be absolutely weatherproof, resistant to high UV levels, colorfast, tear resistant, resistant against microorganisms and the development of stains caused by mould. Beyond that, the product is also very resistant to temperature fluctuations. The PVC layer with air bubbles allows for quick drainage so that the carpet can dry within a short period of time.

CARE AND STORAGE

After opening and positioning the carpet we recommend before first use vacuum cleaning the product to remove any remaining fine dust caused during production. If these dust particles are not removed they can cause abrasions to the carpet.

First of all, we recommend cleaning the carpet in a small area for testing purposes under the cleaning methods listed below. Liquid stains should be removed as quickly as possible as the cleaning process will take longer when left unattended.

For regular cleaning fine dust particles should always and primarily be removed by using a vacuum cleaner. Finer stains can be removed afterwards by using a damp cloth, clean warm water and a mild detergent. From time to time, the carpet may also be cleaned with neutral cleaning agents (PH – 7). Please ensure that all cleaning agents are thoroughly removed to avoid an abrasion to the carpet. The general rule is to use neutral cleaning agents only. For heavier soiling we recommend the use of our STERN Wicker & Textilien Detergent.

Adhesive strips or sticky tape are best cleaned when hardened using ice and then carefully rubbed off using fingers. Alcoholic liquids are removed by pouring cold water over them as soon as possible. After that rub the stain with vinegar. Finally rinse once again with cold water. Coffee and oil stains are also removed by rinsing with cold water immediately. Please ensure to use a neutral cleaning agent afterwards to remove the stain and rinse thoroughly. Urine and excrement stains can be removed with a neutral cleaning agent. Rust film can be removed by scattering salt onto the stain dampened with lemon juice. Leave out to dry in the sun and remove the salt to avoid abrasions.

NOTE

Please note that the carpet may fade slightly when subjected to changes from strong sunlight and rain. To avoid damage caused by waterlogging the carpets should shortly be kept rolled up from time to time.
